Did you know that in America today, the number of students who are not reading at grade level by third grade is 60 percent?

While the average number of young struggling readers in our Catholic school system is not 60 percent, we are close to 20 percent.

That's certainly not good enough for us.

Fortunately, CSCOE found a solution. It's a partnership with Groves Academy, a national expert in reading instruction. We call it *Believe and Read*. It's a three-year program that transforms literacy instruction through outstanding professional development and teacher coaching. One of the things we like best about *Believe and Read* is that it not only supports struggling readers, but it also helps the high flyers!

Today, and thanks to the generosity of Cretin-Derham Hall Catholic High School, *Believe and Read* is being implemented in 33 Catholic schools. Looking to the future, we hope the program can be an option for every one of our schools. However, we can't do it without you.

CSCOE'S IMPACT



Established and/or grew 72 preschool and early childhood programs.



Provided technology assessments and upgrades of WiFi, bandwidth, hardware and professional development in 79 schools that requested them.



Connected and convened more than 2,100 school faculty and staff at the Catholic Schools Summit of Excellence professional development day.



Opened a Latino enrollment office in the heart of the Latino community on Lake Street in Minneapolis. The team personally enrolled nearly 350 new students in the last three years.



In collaboration with the University of St. Thomas, created a STEM Lending Library. In the first two years of operation, 713 loans were provided to 63 schools.



United more than 13,000 Catholic school students to participate in the Mass of the Holy Spirit, an all-school Mass at U.S. Bank Stadium.

OUR VISION

Believe and Read is a best-in-class literacy program. Powered by the Catholic Schools Center of Excellence, and in partnership with Groves Academy and Cretin-Derham Hall Catholic High School, our goal is to ensure every student is at or above grade-level reading by fourth grade – because we believe that God calls every child to greatness.



HOW

Believe and Read brings an explicit, systematic reading instruction and literacy framework to Catholic elementary schools. It is designed to transform one student, one teacher and one school at a time.

EVIDENCE-BASED

Groves Academy is an industry leader with more than 50 years in literacy research and training. Its unique literacy framework has been recognized twice for “Excellence in Education” by the U.S. Department of Education.

COMPLEMENT EXISTING CURRICULUM

The program is designed to improve and enhance the reading teaching methods that schools currently use.

TEACHER SUPPORT

Literacy coaches from Groves Academy work with teachers in participating *Believe and Read* schools over a three-year period. The result of this “train the trainer” approach is sustainability and consistency across participating schools.


PHONICS-BASED INSTRUCTION

In addition to building kids’ vocabulary and comprehension skills through their regular reading lessons, teachers incorporate a daily 30-minute phonics-based lesson to ensure that students are grasping the reading rules they’ll need to one day achieve fluency.



BELIEVE AND READ IS ALREADY WORKING

To date, the results have been transformative. At Holy Spirit Catholic School in St. Paul, one of the initial pilot schools, every single first- and second-grade student was at or above grade level after just one year.

(11-25th)

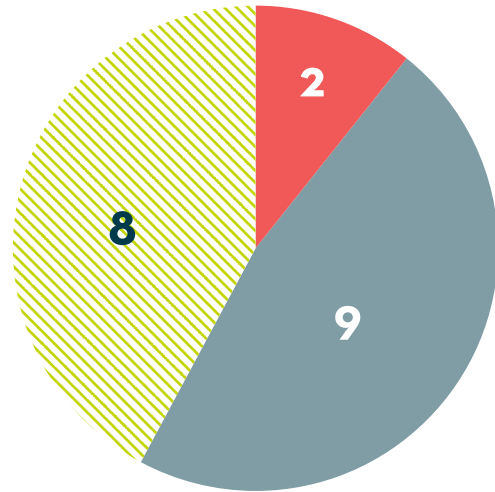

At Grade Level

(76th plus)

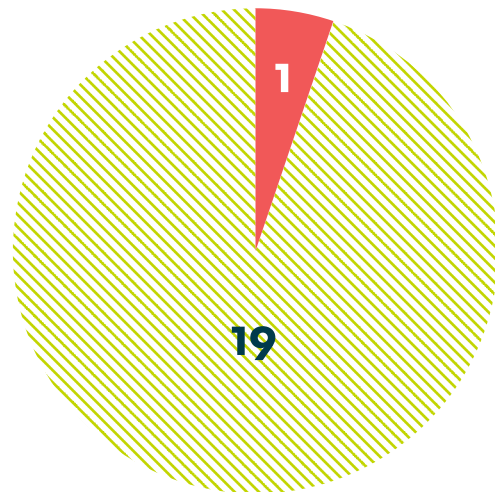

(19 students)

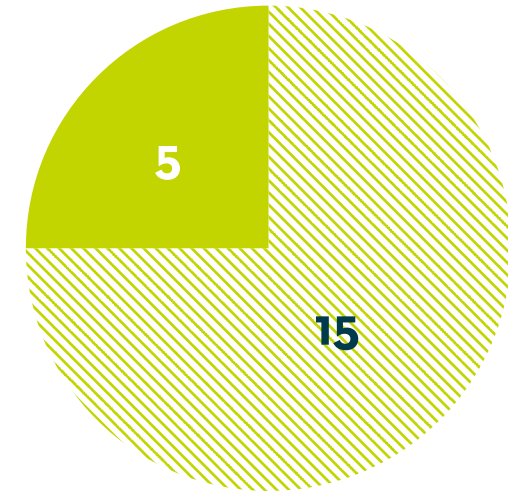


GR 1 Spring 2018
(20 students)

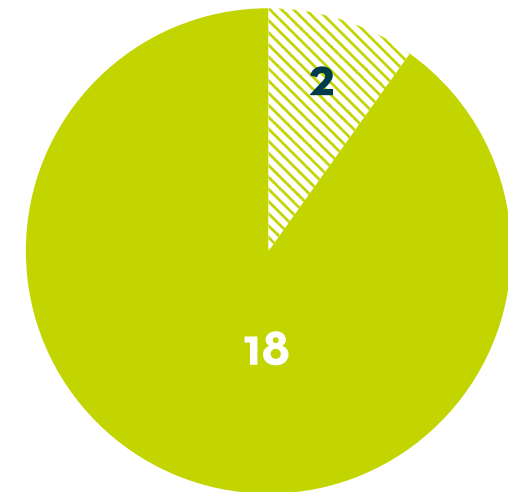


YEAR 2 Grade 2

THE LIFELONG IMPACT OF ILLITERACY

61 percent of Minnesota fourth-graders and 65 percent of U.S. fourth-graders cannot read proficiently.
